 David Hamilton-Eddy, a psychologist working with architectural students, analyses the disintegration of commercial values in Western society.
- The Alexander Pike Autonomous House
 Theoretical studies have been proceeding on this experimental house at the University of Cambridge Department of Architecture, in the Technical Research Division. The house, as conceived by the Director Alex Pike, has been accepted by the Science Research Council who will be funding the studies on a full-size version soon to be built in Cambridge.
- Peter Harper's Directory of 'Alternative technology'
 Peter Harper attempts to do two things at once: to mark out a way for those who wish to know more about the subject; and to provide a general impression for idle voyeurs. He points out that he cannot paint a truly international picture, living as he does in London in a de-institutionalised milieu which precludes the necessary travel, subscriptions and translation.
- Yona Friedman has been able to put some of his theories into practice. His client required a large factory building to be converted for their use as offices. YF worked out the technical side of the design in such a way as to let the employees design the rest of the spatial arrangement for themselves, using, for guidance, YF's handbook for teaching architecture in primary schools.
