

International Association of Hydrogeologists

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Principal activities of IAH are:

- Evaluate international interest among scientists in hydrogeologic studies.
- Sponsor hydrogeologic meetings. IAH has had more than 23 scientific conferences in the past 20 years.
- Publish hydrogeologic reports. For example, *Karst Hydrogeology*, 1977; *Hydrogeology of Great Sedimentary Basins*, 1976; *Hydrogeological Map of Europe and Methods for Evaluation of Ground Water Resources*, 1979.
- Sponsor committees to investigate topics of concern to hydrogeologists.
- Much of IAH is accomplished by several special Commissions.

The Karst Commission of the International Association of Hydrogeologists (IAH) in Cambridge, England, on September 5, 1979, the Association of Karst Hydrogeologists published the first volume of the *Annotated Bibliography in the Spring of 1986*.
