Biring a mearing of the forst Commission of the International Associsting of Hydrogeonegists (IAH) in Cambridge, England, on Emplander 8, 1985, the Association voted to issue the third volume of the Association Mibliography in the Spring of 1986, and additional volumes of the Mibliography every other year. This bulletin represents the first of this new series of LAH bulleties on Karst tertmes.
