Roberta Moscon will join the Research Secretariat for the month of March as ERASMUS+ PAS (Personnel, Admin & Services) exchange from University of Trento, Italy.

As part of the 4 weeks ERASMUS+ mobility, Roberta will assist DTU Aqua's Research Secretariat with delivery of Horizon 2020 FOSTER+ project, and in the process obtain training on EC's Open Science policy priorities relevance to strategic benefits for research performing organisations.



Roberta has held several positions at Un. Trento including International Relations coordinator, and executive director of doctoral programmes. After serving as detached national expert at the European Commission, Directorate General Education and Culture – Unit C2 "Higher Education and Innovation; Entrepreneurship; EIT", has developed a passion for education policies, especially those concerning innovation and modernization of the higher education sector.

In particular, Roberta's interests focus on promoting cooperation among higher education institutions and businesses across Europe fostering inter-sectoral dialogue and debate, as well as encourage the establishment of partnerships and exchange of knowledge and experience on innovative and joint approaches for teaching and learning. She sits on the Steering Committee of European University Association's (EUA) USTREAM Project (Universities for Strategic, Efficient and Autonomous Management) which fosters efficiency in public administration and Higher Education Institutions.

Roberta is also a partner in EUA's EFFECT Project's pilot group on pedagogical staff development, an initiative addressing inclusivity and citizenship skills in higher education.

Currently, Roberta is working at the office of Scientific Publications, Open Access, Research Registry, Publishing Activities at the Un. Trento.

Roberta hopes to leave DTU Aqua with a range to resources, approaches and best practices on how to advise PhD students, researchers and research support staff at Un. Trento on Open Science and Data Management.
